## Sermon Notes

### "Sowing Seeds of Love: A Mother's Legacy"

Galatians 6:7-10

**Main Idea:** A mother's love and actions are like seeds sown, which yield a harvest of blessings for generations to come.

#### I. Introduction

- *Motherhood is a constant demand for the gift of love and caring.*

#### II. The Fundamental Principle of Sowing and Reaping (Galatians 6:7-8)

- Our **actions** have consequences, just as seeds planted yield a harvest.
- Sowing and Reaping = **Planting** and **Harvesting**
  - Proverbs 11:18
  - James 3:18
- What we sow today will impact future generations.

#### III. The Tenderness of a Mother's Heart (Galatians 6:9a)

- Weariness and perseverance.
- An example from Lois and Eunice
  - 2 Timothy 1:5
  - 2 Timothy 3:14 -15
- Keep sowing seeds of **faith**, even when it feels difficult.

#### IV. The Harvest of Mother's Blessing (Galatians 6:9b-10)

- God promises a harvest if we do not **give up**.
- We have the chance to do good to all, especially within our families.
  - Hosea 10:12
- Look beyond immediate results and trust God's **timing**.

#### V. Action Points:

- Mothers, continue to sow seeds of love, kindness, and grace in your families.
- Pray for mothers, their strength, and their influence.
- If possible, call your mom today and thank her for her sacrificial love and perseverance.
