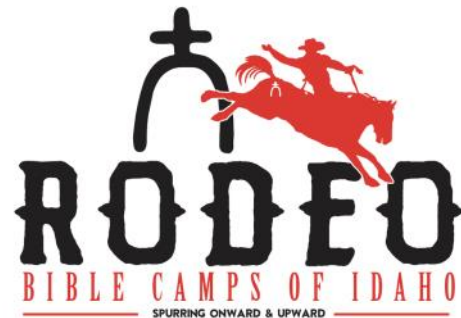
**RODEO BIBLE CAMPS OF IDAHO** is coming to Washington County Fairgrounds in Cambridge, June 16-20.

### CLASSIC SUMMER STORIES: OLD TESTAMENT

#### “A Godly Father in an Evil Age”

Genesis 6:5-14, 22

Introduction – Godly fathers needed!

I. A godly father finds **grace** in the eyes of the LORD.

“But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.” - **Genesis 6:8**

II. A godly father **pursues** righteousness and faithfulness.

“Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God.” - **Genesis 6:9**

III. A godly father **obeys** God.

“Noah did everything just as God commanded him.” - **Genesis 6:22**

“And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family. By his faith he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.” - **Hebrews 11:6-7**
